





Tools required


Installation requires a screwdriver, an adjustable wrench and adjustable pliers




Installation

Identify all components are present prior to starting installation.


Flush water through the mains water feed to ensure they are clear of debris and isolate the water feed. Stop valve in the pictures is not supplied .




Mount the kitchen tap on the sink. See Fig 1




Firstly slide the Rubber Gasket (B) over the hoses, followed by the Metal Washer (C) and then the Mounting Nut (D) onto the stem. Hand tighten them firmly.See Fig 2




Use a Phillips head screwdriver to thread the 2 screws. See Fig 3




Connect the Three-way connector (E) onto the cold water supply on right. Connect the Cold Water Supply Hose (H) onto the Three-way connector. Secure with an adjustable wrench. See Fig 4




Connect the Hot Water Supply Hose (G) onto the hot water supply on left. Secure with an adjustable wrench. See Fig 5




Connect the Drinking Water Supply Hose (F) onto the other side of the Three-way Connector, and secure the connection with an adjustable wrench. Fit the other end of the hose (F) into the filter housing inlet. See Fig 6




Fit the Drinking Water Outlet Hose (I) into the filter housing outlet. See Fig $7\,$



Operation



To activate the filtered water, turn the lever outwards without lifting the lever



Open the handle to the right and the water will come out. Turn the handle forward (hot water)or backward (cold water)to control the water temperature .

Troubleshooting

Kitchen tap dripping for short period after closure :

This is normal as the spout is emptying.

Kitchen tap dripping continually: Turn off the water supply, remove the cartridge and clean and check internal seat for debris

No water coming through: Check pipes and inside of mixer for blockages


Slow Flow from the spout: The water filter must be changed every 6 months

Water not mixing: Pressures should be balanced or the higher pressure will restrict the lower

Cartridge become stiff: remove cartridge and clean out debris

Maintenance

Turn off water supply before removing the cartridge.



- 1. Take out the handle cap (1) and use the allen key to screw out the grub screw (2).
- 2. Remove the handle (3) and screw out the dome (4).
- 3. Loosen the locking nut (5) by the wrench and take out the cartridge (6) .
- 4. Clean the cartridge and reinstall the cartridge in reverse steps (6).

Cleaning

Clean the product surface with a soft cloth and a mild detergent or citric acid solution. The use of any rough materials, as well as corrosive or abrasive cleaning agents, is not recommended as they may cause damage to the coating.
